I hope you've been well since we last communicated. During our telephone conversation in late September, we discussed several things including student academic records that were illegally provided to *The News and Observer* in violation of federal law. Since that time, the records we discussed have been carefully inspected. Our examination includes the possibility that the security of email accounts associated with your communications may have been compromised. I'm writing to ask that you please consider calling me so we can discuss this.

Your assistance of our efforts to protect your own privacy, as well as the privacy granted the university's students by federal law, would be sincerely appreciated.
